

## Rules and regulations for participating in windsurfing & SUP courses

All participants of the relevant courses at the University Sports Center are requested to comply with the following rules and regulations. Gross infringements may lead to being expelled from class.

- 1. Avoid in particular the swimming area of the water sports facilities, nearby shipping lines, and the sailboats attached to buoys.
- 2. Be particularly considerate of swimmers and other guests at the facilities.
- 3. Please handle all provided equipment with utmost care. In case of damage caused by gross negligence or intent, we will have to demand compensation from you.
- 4. Please do not take out equipment on your own. Wait for your teacher's **instructions**.
- 5. If you notice any damaged equipment, please inform your instructor immediately.
- 6. Make sure you remain strictly within the indicated boundaries.
- 7. Try to stay within earshot of your instructor at all times.
- 8. In case of an emergency or damage, please stay on your board and send a sign to your teacher.
- 9. After class, listen to instructions and, **together**, put away windsurf boards, rigs or SUP boards.
- 10. Please rinse off and return the borrowed water sports clothing according to the instructions of the teacher.
- 11. Leave valuables at home or store them in a locker.
- 12. Create carpools to help the environment and save money.
- 13. Classes take place under **all** weather conditions. If bad weather keeps you off the water, we will not be able to refund your money or offer a make-up day. Instead, we'll have class on land or indoors.
- 14. Wearing a personal flotation device (life jacket or Restube) is ALWAYS mandatory.
